



What is the Child Dental Benefits Schedule?

is a program that provides eligible children and over two calendar years for basic dental care. teenagers up to \$1,095 in Medicare benefits The Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS)

Is my child eligible for the CDBS?

Children and teenagers are eligible for the CDBS if they are:

- aged 0 to 17 years for any one day of the calendar year
