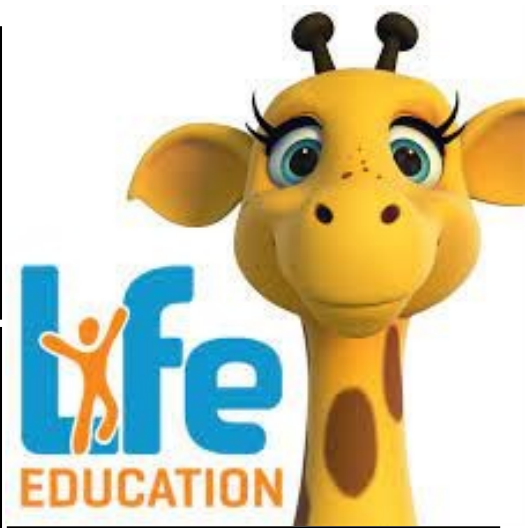
DO YOU KNOW SOMEONE STARTING KINDERGARTEN IN 2026?
